Routine non-urgent care:

- Prescription Refills
- Vaccinations
- Follow-Up Visits

Same day appointments for:

- Common illnesses - colds/flu, stomach virus, ear aches, sore throats
- migraines
- urinary/bladder infections
- fever/rashes
- sprains
- back pain
- minor cuts/burns
- minor broken bones

QUICK CARE WALK-IN CLINIC treats non-life-threatening medical problems. (Including but not limited to):

Common illnesses:

- Colds/flu
- Stomach virus
- Vomiting
- Ear aches
- Sore throats
- Urinary and bladder infections

Common injuries:

- Simple cuts/burns
- Minor sprains
- Contusions, mild concussions
- Migraines, dizziness
- Insect bites, stings & poison ivy
- Pink eye
- Abdominal pain
- STD screening
- Simple foreign body removal
- Children who are 3 months or older

EMERGENCY CARE

Emergency Care when you need care right away. Symptoms that may indicate an emergency medical condition include:

- Chest pain, heart attack, or palpitations
- Sudden onset of severe abdominal pain
- Severe allergic reaction or anaphylaxis
- Severe shortness of breath
- Trauma
- Severe pain
- Head injuries
- Accidental poisoning
- Chemical exposure
- Loss of consciousness or shock
- Eye injuries
- Foreign body removal
- Severe burns
- Coughing or vomiting blood

Symptoms of a stroke: numbness in the face, arm or leg, slurred speech, sudden dizziness/weakness, loss of coordination/balance, sudden vision changes, severe headache
